PARISH 200 CLUB FINANCE REPORT 2021-22: We have come to the end of the 2021-22, 200 club year and I would like to thank all of you who have participated and the collectors, without whom the 200 club could not continue. I have balanced the books and thought you would be interested to see how much you have raised for the Parish funds. A total of **£8,753** has been collected from participants of the club. From this figure, **£5,520** has been given in prize money and **£3,251** has gone into Parish funds. We have, at present, **32** vacant numbers. Although there are these vacant numbers, it has been decided that the prize money should not be altered, as we do not wish loyal participants to lose out. However, it would be great if we could fill these numbers for the next year and gain back some of the **£1621** lost this year for the Parish. Please consider either joining the 200 club at £1 per week, or even possibly having a 2nd number, perhaps in your children or grandchildren's name. This will give the Parish further funding and it also gives you a chance of a winning number. The prizes include **8 x £500 & 8 x £100** during the year. I have put a list at the back of our churches of this year's winners. Congratulations to you all.
